## **Notes to this membership application**

By signing the application, you declare that you have read and accepted without reserve the following documents as binding:

- a) the Council's bylaws
- b) the Council's bylaws covering membership fees.

With your signature, you accept the duty of promoting, supporting, and representing the Council's goals and intentions set forth in its bylaws.

In return, you may use the designations "Member of the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Nachhaltiges Bauen e.V." and "Member of the German Sustainable Building Council" as well as the Council's logo in your own public relations work.

As an ordinary member, you have full voting rights in elections, resolutions, and determinations at general assemblies and in candidacies for the Presidium and the certification committee.

Other members of the Council do not have voting rights and cannot be elected to the Council's bodies, with the exception of the expert committee.

Membership does not include the right to use the sustainable-building certificate issued by the Council in all cases.

Information about membership category (such as "A2: Consulting and planning agencies, 15 employees"): to the extent that the membership fee relates to the member's information provided regarding revenue or staff size, the member must provide this information to the Council or pay the highest annual membership fee. Information about members is handled confidentially. The fee for the current year is based on the information provided for the previous year. Anyone who performs work for the member is counted as an employee. Revenue is counted in net amounts. If the member cannot be unambiguously assigned to one of the categories, the Council's Presidium shall make the assignment in accordance of the Council's bylaws.
